In Psalm 65:1-4, we learn that God is Worthy of Praise.

According to Psalm 66:5-12 there are two reasons for praise and confidence in God.

The event of deliverance, vv 5-7.

The crossing of the Red Sea and of the Jordan (6) proved decisively God's power and will to save His people and judge the rebellious (7). ... It is a past event whose repercussions are forever (7).¹

The event of discipline, 8-12.

For God has cast His people as it were into a smelting-furnace or fining-pot in order to purify and to prove them by suffering.²

According to Psalm 67, Why does God bless his children with abundance? Two reasons

1. **He is a good God who wants his children to enjoy them, e.g. 1 Timothy 6:17.**
2. He wants “various nations on the face of the earth come to the point where they recognize the futility of their own gods and the supremacy of the only God, the God of Israel.”³

According to Psalm 68 notes, remembering God's Great Deeds in the past give us Confidence in the Future.
